Practicum in a Pandemic SLRLN Tech Expo (2021) The UMSL OA Practicum in a Pandemic Project began in April of 2020 at the beginning of the Covid-19 crisis. The pandemic made it impossible for many graduate students to finish or find an in-person library practicum opportunity. By devising and supervising a remote practicum for 14 SISTL students, each with over 90 hours of work each to complete over the course of 2020. With supervision the students collaborated to develop, document, enact, and update a workflow for reviewing faculty works and discovering and harvesting Open Access articles.
